

MINUTES

**FROM THE NEGOTIATION MEETING
ON THE TEXT OF AGREEMENT
BETWEEN
THE COUNCIL OF MINISTERS OF BOSNIA AND HERZEGOVINA
AND THE GOVERNMENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF AZERBAIJAN
ON INTERNATIONAL ROAD TRANSPORT**

The negotiation meeting was held on 4 and 5 February 2016 in Sarajevo.

The composition of the Delegations is in the Annex 1 of this Minutes.

The basis for the discussion is the text of the Agreement between the Council of Ministers of Bosnia and Herzegovina and the Republic of Azerbaijan on the International Road Transport that has been proposed by the Azerbaijani side.

The agreed text of the Agreement in English language was initialled and is attached in Annex 2 of this Minutes. Both Delegations have committed to make further efforts to finalise their internal procedures in order to facilitate signing of the Agreement at the earliest convenience.

In terms of transport of goods, the two Delegations agreed that, until the entry into force of the Agreement, the competent authorities of the two countries will exchange for 2016 the total of 100 permits for bilateral/transit transport and 50 permits valid for transport to/from third countries that will be valid until 31 January next year.

Taking into account that the drivers from Bosnia and Herzegovina are required to obtain visas in order to perform international road transport to Azerbaijan, it has been proposed to the Delegation of Azerbaijan to delegate this issue to the competent authorities in their country.

The talks were held in a friendly and cordial atmosphere and were completed to the satisfaction of both sides.
