

Driving Restrictions, Goods Transport Turkey

Driving restrictions apply to heavy goods vehicles from 6h00 to 10h00 and from 16h00 to 22h00 every day on the Fatih Sultan Mehmet Bridge (FSM), which connects Europe and Asia. Vehicles transporting dangerous goods are allowed to cross the bridge from 02h00 to 06h00. This regulation is also valid for the transport of "limited quantity" (LQ) ADR goods.

Vehicles transporting the following dangerous goods: ADR "Class 2 Gases" have to use ferries.

Only cars and vans are allowed to cross the Bosphorus Bridge. Heavy goods vehicles are forbidden and have to use the Fatih Sultan Mehmet Bridge.

There are no driving restrictions on goods vehicles at weekends or on public holidays.
